MINUTES

The Clover Town Council held a special meeting on October 19, 2006, after proper notification. Mayor Donnie Burris and Council members Wes Spurrier, Granita Boyd, Bruce Henderson, Ann Harvey and Jay Dover were present. Councilman Robert Jackson was absent. Allison Harvey, Town Administrator was also present. There were no members of the press present.

CALL TO ORDER

Councilman Spurrier made a motion to allow Public Address before second reading on Ordinance 06-17. Councilman Henderson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

(Amended) PUBLIC ADDRESS

1. Bill Archer spoke to Council against Ordinance 06-17 implementing local Hospitality Tax. Mr. Archer said he knew the ordinance was pretty much a done deal but wanted to let Council know he was not in favor of the Hospitality Tax. He said the money should go toward attracting businesses to the area instead of festivals.
2. Dean Archer spoke to Council concerning the Hospitality Ordinance. He said the festivals and such are a burden on downtown businesses. Mr. Archer said it will also be more paper work for businesses to keep up with.
